

### **Annotation of the course 'Health Economics'**

The Health Economics course is studied by the students from specialty Dental Medicine, 1<sup>st</sup> course 1<sup>st</sup> semester.

The purpose of training is to be obtained basic theoretical and applied knowledge about production, financing, distribution and consumption of health services and goods in the national economy.
