ORDINANCE

No. RD-01-154/26.03.2020

for the amendment of Ordinance No. RD-01-124 of 13.03.2020, amended and supplemented by Ordinance No. RD-01-131 of 17.03.2020, Ordinance No. RD-01-139 of 19.03.2020 and Ordinance No. RD-01-144 of 22.03.2020.

Pursuant to Art. 63 of the Health Act, Art. 73 of the Administrative Procedure Code and in connection with the increasingly exacerbating epidemic situation related to the spread of the COVID-19 virus on the country's territory and the state of emergency declared by Decision of the National Assembly of the Republic of Bulgaria on 13.03.2020 and the recommendations by the National Operational Headquarters established by Ordinance No. R-37/26.02.2020 of the Prime Minister of the Republic of Bulgaria

I ORDER:

1. Ordinance No. RD-01-124 of 13.03.2020, amended and supplemented by Ordinance No. RD-01-131 of 17.03.2020, Ordinance No. RD-01-139 of 19.03.2020 and Ordinance No. RD-01-144 of 22.03.2020, to be amended and the term of the introduced anti-epidemic measures until April 12, 2020, inclusive to be extended.

2. Payment service providers shall be allowed to work in big retail centers such as shopping malls, in strict compliance with sanitary and hygiene requirements, including disinfection, air circulation and instructions for personal hygiene of staff, provision of personal protective equipment and not allowing employees to work with manifestations of symptoms of acute contagious diseases.

3. This Ordinance shall be announced to the regional health inspectorates, regional governors, mayors and directors of the regional directorates of the Ministry of Interior, who shall notify interested parties and create an organization to carry out control over the implementation of the specified measures in the extended term.
