

Instructions for on-line based final test of “Latin and medical terminology” for first year students of Medicine, Dental medicine and Pharmacy, Bulgarian and English programmes.

I. Date of the test

1. Penultimate week of the summer semester (third week of May – 18.05-22.05. 2020) during the regular weekly classes for each group established in the second semester schedule.
2. Each teacher presents a schedule for the final test to the head of the Foreign Languages Section – dr V. Kelbecheva.

II. Content of the final test

The final test consists of the following 5 tasks:

1. Translation from Latin to English 20 p.
2. Translation from English to Latin 35p.
3. Explanation of clinical terms composed by Greek elements 10p.
4. Composing a clinical term with Greek elements corresponding to a given explanation 10p.
5. Use of prepositions and cases with terminological expressions 15p.
Five examples – 2 with non-agreed and 3 with agreed attribute.
The overall test score is 90p. Positive mark is considered when 45 p. are achieved.

III. Technical regulations.

1. Duration of the test is 45 minutes.
2. In the beginning of the class, the teacher publishes different variants of the test in Assignments section in MS Teams and then attributes a variant to each student.
3. During the final test students have to work with their microphones turned off. Questions to the teacher might be asked in the chat.
4. The final test is in .doc or .docx format (default file formats in MS Word).
Students work on the file sent to them by the teacher.
When the student is finished with their work on the test, they upload back their file in Assignments.

Instructions and recommendations for students on the conducting of and preparation for distance term tests and third oral exam in the Bulgarian Language Section of (DLST)

Following preparatory tests, piloted through the system, the necessary steps are:

For a test conducted through FORMS (English as language of instruction)

1. Access: “Assignments”.
2. In the “Assigned task” menu you can see the test that must be opened through Teams via FORMS.
3. Fill in the form by choosing the correct answers to the given task.
4. After the final completion of the test for a fixed time (30 minutes) the student is obliged to turn it in before the deadline using the TURN IN button.
5. At the beginning of the week following the test students can check their **results** again through “Assignments”.
6. The “completed task” option allows students to see, the checked and evaluated under the given evaluation criteria test sent by the teacher.
