Dear students of dental medicine,

The exam in neurology for dental students during the winter session of the academic year 2020 - 2021 will be conducted remotely through the Microsoft Office 365 platform and the applications MS Teams, MS Forms.

• The necessary technical requirements for student participation in the exam are:

- 1. Device with installed camera, microphone and network connectivity with parameters not lower than 5 Mbps download speed and 5 Mbps upload. You can check your speed here. It is recommended that the student be in a quiet environment to limit background noise, preferably with the use of headphones.
- 2. Installed or browser access to MS Teams. When using a browser, we recommend the latest versions of Microsoft Edge or Google Chrome.

During the exam:

- 1. Students must show their student books before the exam at the assistant, proving their identity.
- 2. Students must check that they have access to the system before the announced class, without access to the materials, in order to eliminate possible connectivity problems. Students must have joined the relevant meeting no later than 10 minutes before the start of the exam.
- 3. Students must turn on their cameras and microphones at the beginning of the meeting before receiving the test, and they must remain on at all times until the assistant / conservator has explicitly indicated when they can be turned off!
- 4. Students are not allowed to use the keyboard unless they answer a question that requires entering information.
- 5. The exam will take the form of a test assigned through Assignments through MS Teams and MS Forms. Students must open the test using the View Assignment button and start completing it.
- 6. At the discretion of the examining assistants, they may require students to share screen content or provide a view from another angle to the room.

- 7. The exam test contains 50 questions, of which 35 MCQ questions that require one or more correct answers and 15 open questions that require a free answer. The number of points and the correct answers are indicated for each question. If more answers than the indicated number are indicated, the question will be evaluated with 0 points. The maximum number of points on all test questions is 120 points, of which 80 points are for neurology and 40 points for psychiatry.
- 8. At the end of the test, students press the "Submit" button.
- 9. The time for solving the test will be limited 50 minutes. Tests obtained after the time will not be evaluated, respectively students will receive a poor grade.
- 10. You will receive the test results at a later stage. The final grade of the exam will be formed on the basis of the result of the exam test, reviewed by an examination commission with the participation of habilitated persons from the Department of Neurology and the Department of Psychiatry. The two disciplines will be assessed separately, with a minimum of 61% of each of the two disciplines required. The final grade will be based on the grades from both disciplines. Each grade will be considered on the principle from 61 to 70% of correct answers average (3), from 71 to 80% of correct answers good (4), from 81 to 90% of correct answers very good (5), and over 91% of the correct answers excellent (6).
