

INSTRUCTIONS

*For a distance exam of Orthopedics and Traumatology with
5th medical course, winter semester of the academic year 2020/2021.*

I. The necessary technical requirements for participation in the exam are:

- Device with camera, microphone and network connection with parameters not lower than 5 Mbps download speed and 5 Mbps upload speed (you can check your speed [here: https://fast.com](https://fast.com));
- Installed or browser access to [MS Teams](#). When using a browser, we recommend the latest versions of [Microsoft Edge](#) or [Google Chrome](#);

II. Exam format:

- The semester exam of Orthopedics and Traumatology consists of two parts - passive test and oral exam. The test contains 10 questions and each question has only one correct answer. The oral exam consists of an answer to two questions from the Orthopedics and Traumatology conspectus.
- A Team in Microsoft Teams will be created for each exam session. The exam will start at 08.00 a.m. Bulgarian time and a video meeting will be started. Students must be on time for the meeting, with a camera and a microphone switched on. Once the meeting has started and the students have joined, a link to the test will be posted. Students remain with camera and microphone on until the end of the test. The time for working on the test is 15 minutes. **After the set time has finished, the test cannot be accepted in the system and graded!** After completing the first part of the exam, each student will receive a video call through Microsoft Teams for the oral exam. Students must be online and wait for a call after the test.

III. Evaluation and grading:

- After successfully passing the test (0,1,2 mistakes), students are admitted to the oral exam. The grade from the oral exam is calculated from the arithmetic mean value of the grades from the answers to the two questions from Orthopedics and Traumatology conspectus.
