

**DISASTER MEDICINE EXAM
ADMINISTRATIVE NOTES**

SPECIALTY “MEDICINE” AND “DENTAL MEDICINE”

Dear Colleagues,

The exam consists of two parts: test and writing an essay on 2 chosen topics.

Test includes 15 MCQ covering all the topics of the syllabus. The format is the same as the colloquium test. You have to choose from 4 given answers. Every question has only one correct answer. Every correct answer is valued with 1 point. In order to pass the test 8 points are required. The scale is as follows:

8, 9 points - 3

10, 11 points - 4

12, 13 points - 5

14, 15 points - 6

All those of you with grade 3 and above on the test will participate into written part. Into the written part you extract two questions from the syllabus and you have to write an essay on both of them. Poor mark on 1 of the topics means fail on the exam. You will have 1 hour to write your essays.

The overall grade is formed by 3 components:

20% is coming from the average grade from the colloquiums; 30% is from the final test and 50% from the essays.
