

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE FINAL EXAM IN
„FORENSIC MEDICINE“
ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/2022 FOR ENGLISH STUDENTS OF THE SPECIALTY:
DENTAL MEDICINE**

Due to the epidemic situation in the country and a decision of the Rector , the exam will be performed **remotely as a test** using the platform Microsoft Teams for video and audio control of students during the exam.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE EXAM:

- ❖ Personal computer (PC)/Tablet/Smart phone with a working camera and microphone during the whole duration of the exam;
 - ❖ Internet connection with download and upload speed no less than 5 Mbps. You can test the speed of your connection here: <https://fast.com>;
 - ❖ Each student will be included in a team and will be under video and audio surveillance.
 - ❖ The exam dates are **12.01.2022 and 13.01.2022**
 - ❖ The teams are as follows:
 - Groups: 23, 24, 25, 27 – 12.01.2022 starting at 09:00 o'clock
 - Groups: 26, 28, 29 – 12.01.2022 starting at 10:30 o'clock
 - Groups: 19, 20, 21, 22 – 13.01.2022 starting at 09:00 o'clock
 - Groups: 30, 31, 32 – 13.01.2022 starting at 10:30 o'clock
 - ❖ All students must be online in Microsoft Teams atleast **10 minutes before the start of the exam.**
 - ❖ **At the start of the exam**, each student must turn on their camera and microphone so a member of the jury can check their attendance by name.
 - ❖ Conversation and comments during the whole duration of the exam are not allowed.
 - ❖ The time for the test starts wrom the moment of sharing of the link in the general chat in the team. The jury members will remind about the remaining time 10 minutes before the end of the exam.
 - ❖ If the student finishes their test before the end of the exam, they should submit it and stay online with their camera and microphone on, without asking questions and conversing with the rest of the students UNTIL THE END OF THE EXAM IS DECLARED.
 - ❖ The exam results will be published immediately after the end of the exam.
- The exam will be held using **Microsoft Forms or Office 365**. The test will consist of **50 MSQs**, with a maximum score of **100 points**. The exam questions will be with only ONE correct answer and will be based on the topics studied during the semseter.
