

## Information for the semester exam “Propaedeutics of Surgical Diseases”

Start of the exam - 08:00 am on the 10<sup>th</sup> floor – Pediatric Surgery Clinic.

Late students will not be allowed to participate in the exam!

1. The examination starts with a MCQ test for 30 minutes with 1 correct answer. Attached is a sample test on our website.

2. After successfully passing the test, one written question will be given with a writing time of 60 minutes.

3. The next stage of the exam will be held on the 10<sup>th</sup> floor – Pediatric Surgery Clinic after checking the written works. You will be asked randomly to enter 2 by 2 in one of the study rooms to be examined by the professors in practical and theory parts of the exam.

**NB:** It is allowed to attend the exam only on the given date for your student’s group!

The grade of all parts of the exam will be taken into account, as well as the personal impression of the student's professor during the past academic year.

### **For exam resit attempts:**

Students who failed on the exam and irregular ones can be informed for the given resit dates by the Student Service Department.

For the resit exam you **need** to register in Pediatric Surgery Clinic a week before the exam date.

You can attend **only one** resit date, after registration.
