

## **INFORMATION FOR THE FINAL EXAMS IN MIDWIFERY**

The exact dates of the exam, for every group, will be provided separately in the lectures channel.

The exam is at the end of the fourth semester and it will be held in person. The exam itself is held in one day for all students. It is mainly in the form of a test, which includes 35 questions from the lecture course, each with 4 answers, one of which is correct. The test is updated annually. The time to solve the test is 1 hour. Followed by a check within another 1 hour and announcing the results. Students must answer a minimum of 60% of the questions in order to receive a grade mark of "average" 3. Then there is an option for additional interviews on a topic related to the test, for questions that have been given a wrong answer. This interview is not mandatory for all students, but only for those who are not satisfied with the test score or at the discretion of the examiner for those students from whom he has any impression of their participation in the lecture course (irregular or greater activity with questions where a better test result is expected or if the student wants to get a higher grade).

At the end of their training in the specialty, the students have a state exam, which combines the disciplines of "pediatrics" and "neonatology". The exam is written and has two parts. The general part is on pediatrics. An exam ticket is drawn, which includes two questions from the material included in the lecture course. An essay is written and is evaluated by a commission that usually includes the two lecturers. The opportunity for an interview is given again and a final assessment is formed.

The results of the exams are entered in the student books and the protocol sent in advance by the students department. Then the grades are entered in the official book within the files of each student.

Those who receive a poor grade in the exam reappear at the remedial session in September.
