



Requirements for Theoretical Exam of Pharmacognosy Part II

- The exam will take the form of test and it will include **40 questions**.
- The time for completion is **80 min**.
- The exam consists of:
 - 10 Open questions with short answer;
 - 10 Open questions (chemical structure);
 - 20 Closed questions with two correct answers.
- For correct answers by questions of type:
 - **10 Open questions - you get 3 points** (Note: if the question is not fully answered - you get 1 or 2 points);
 - **10 Open questions (chemical structure) - you get 3 points**
 - **20 Closed questions with two correct answers - you get 2 points** (Note: if you have 1 correct answer from two - you get 1 point; if you have one correct and one wrong answer - you get 0 points).
- The maximum number of points for the exam is **100**. The grading is based on a percentage of correct responses:
 - Poor (2) - less or equal to 60 points (below 60%);
 - Average (3) - from 61 to 70 points (61-70%);
 - Good (4) - from 71 to 80 points (71-80%);
 - Very Good (5) - from 81 to 90 points (81-90%);
 - Excellent (6) - from 91 to 100 points (91-100%).
- The results will be announced within a week after the exam.

- **Students who have not passed successfully the Practical exam do not have the right to attend the theoretical exam of Pharmacognosy Part II!**
