Kindly be advised that in order to ensure the efficient coordination of the examination procedure, students are required to gather in the lobby of the Department of Epidemiology and MBS (Study building 2), located on the fifth level, at **7:15** on the designated date.

**The exam has three components**

- 1. Infectious diseases and tropical medicine**
- 2. Epidemiology**
- 3. Parasitology**

**The final grade is an average of the three components mentioned above.**

### **Infectious Diseases and Tropical Medicine Exam Format**

1. Entry test of 25 multiple choice questions with one correct answer each.
2. Two writing questions from the conspectus (one question from section 1 and one question from section 2 from the conspectus).

Students, who answer at least 15 multiple choice questions correctly in the entry test, continue with the writing tasks.

If the stop test is not passed, the student gets a poor mark and fails the exam. The student should resit the exam.

In the writing task, both questions are evaluated. If one of the two questions gets a poor mark, the student fails the exam. The student should resit the exam.
