

PHARMACOLOGY EXAMINATION INFORMATION
Master of Pharmacy 3rd year – English course

- Students take the exam according to the schedule for the respective student group.
- Start of the exam - 08:00. Students must be in the hall 15 minutes before the start of the exam.

The exam begins with an ENTRANCE TEST – 40 MCQs with one correct answer. The time for completion is 30 minutes.

TEST - Grading scale:

- Poor (2) - a score below 24 points (below 60%);
- Average (3) - 24 to 28 points incl. (61 - 70%);
- Good (4) - 29 to 32 points incl. (71 - 80%);
- Very Good (5) - 33 to 36 points incl. (81 - 90%);
- Excellent (6) - 36 to 40 points incl. (91 - 100%).

Students who have successfully passed the test, acquire the right to take a WRITTEN EXAM on two questions from the syllabus for 60 minutes. Students, who successfully pass the written exam (with a score above Average 3.00 on each of the two questions), acquire the right to take an ORAL EXAM. At the oral exam the student pick up a ticket with 6 prescription tasks. To pass this part of the exam, the student has to write correctly at least 6 prescriptions. The last part of the examination consists of interview with the examination commission on the prescriptions and the questions included in the syllabus.

The FINAL GRADE from the exam is formed according to the approved standard in the discipline, as follows: entrance test, written exam, oral exam, grades from the colloquiums in the first and second semester, and the grade in the subject for the academic year.
