



Instructions for the final exam in Chemistry for students of Medicine and Dental medicine

The exam is going to be held according to schedule. It has 2 parts – written and oral examination. The written exam is 90 minutes. The paper for the written exam contains 20 open questions similar to those in training files. They require short precise answer. To pass this part you need to have 51 points (60%) out of 85. Students who pass the written exam will sit for the oral examination. You will be asked questions on the material similar to those you have been asked during the practical lessons and in training files. Final mark is based on the average mark from colloquiums, mark from the written exam and mark from the oral exam. In the day of the written exam you have to come 15 min earlier in front of the auditorium. The assistants will invite you to seat in auditorium group by group.

Prepare by:

- 1) Having a red book
- 2) Having a pen – blue or black ink pen. Pens with other colors and highlighters are not allowed
- 3) Having a calculator
- 4) Having your phone and smart watch on silent mode/switched off in your bag
- 5) Having everything else in your bag and ready to leave it at the front.

If the student fails the final written test or the oral exam, they fail the entire exam.
