



Microbiology Retake Exam Rules and Regulations for students from specialty “Pharmacy”

1. The Microbiology Exam will be held in person in the Auditorium Complex of the Medical University - Plovdiv. MU – Plovdiv will provide laptops in Auditorium hall №8, 3-rd floor.
2. The exam includes a total of 62 questions for 50 min.:
 - 2.1. 20 (twenty) questions with 1 correct answer – “yes”/“no” or “true”/“false”. Each question is rated by 1 point.
 - 2.2. 20 (twenty) questions with 1 correct answer out of 4 possible. Each question is rated by 2 points.
 - 2.3. 20 (twenty) questions with 2 correct answers out of 6 possible. Each question is rated by 4 points. If 2 answers are marked, but only one of them is correct, the student will receive 2 points out of the maximum 4 points. If more than 2 answers are marked, the student will receive 0 points for the question.
 - 2.4. 2 clinical cases with 3 sub-questions to each case with 1 correct answer out of 4 possible. Each question is rated by 2 points.
3. The total number of points for the whole test is 152. The test is passed when the student has received at least 65% of them, i.e. 99 points.

Test score:

- < 65% correct answers - Poor (2);
- 65% -71% correct answers - Average (3);
- 72% - 83% correct answers – Good (4);
- 84% - 93% correct answers – Very good (5);
- ≥ 94% correct answers – Excellent (6)

The final exam mark is formed according to item 8.

4. The exam will be held on 11.09.2024 for English – speaking students specialty “Pharmacy”.
5. On this date, 1 session will be organized:

- for English - speaking students specialty "Pharmacy" 08:00 am -09:00 am;
Student allocation in exam dates and hours will be scheduled by the department

6. Students are not allowed to:
 - 6.1. have their mobile phones turned on;
 - 6.2. record the exam;
 - 6.3. hint/cheat
7. The exam shall be cancelled if:
 - 7.1. the mobile phone is turned on;
 - 7.2. the student records the exam;
 - 7.3. the student attempts to hint/cheat
8. Leading role in the final mark assessment will be the mark of the exam, but also important is the persistence in the preparation of the student, reflected in the current term assessment, which participates up to 25% in the formation of the final grade.
9. At the discretion of the examination commission the student can also pass an oral examination.
10. Students will be notified of their marks within 1 week of the exam date.
11. Students must know their **username and password** to access their personal institutional account! **If your account password contains letters other than Latin, you will not be able to log in, as only English keyboard is installed on the exam laptops! In this case, before the exam, you must change your password by the specified requirements.** In case of a need for password change or other problems with the account, the student is obliged to contact the IT department **within 3 days before the exam. The exam will be cancelled for students that do not meet this condition and are not able to access their personal account on the day of the exam.** All students are instructed how to conduct the exam in a controlled electronic environment through instructions distributed through Sharepoint and on the website of the Department of Microbiology and Immunology.
12. All students must be in the exam hall 15 minutes before the start time of the exam.
