

Instructions for the State Examination in Pharmacology and Toxicology

The exam consists of two parts - a written and an oral exam. The written exam lasts 1 hour and 30 minutes and includes two questions - one question the part Pharmacology and one question from the part Toxicology of the syllabus. Each student picks up individual questions. Students, who successfully pass the written part of the exam **in both disciplines** acquire the right to take the oral exam.

The oral exam may include questions on **different topics** included in the syllabus.
