EXAM INSTRUCTIONS

Pharmacoeconomics

The theoretical exam will be held according to the following schedule:

Subject	Date and Groups	Start Time
Pharmacoeconomics	20.01.2025, all groups	09:00

Information about the exam procedure:

- Location: Auditorium complex at the Medical University of Plovdiv, 1st floor, Auditorium I.
- The exam will begin at 9:00 AM. Students must be in the exam hall 15 minutes before the start of the exam.
- All electronic devices (e.g., mobile phones, smart watches) are submitted to the invigilators completely switched off (airplane or any similar mode is not allowed).
- Students are required to bring their student books (red books), a blue pen, and a calculator.

Information about the exam format:

The exam will consist of two parts:

1. **First part (theoretical)** – A test with 40 questions covering the entire pharmacoeconomics syllabus:
 - 15 statements where the student must indicate whether the statement is true or false. Each correct answer is worth 1 point.
 - 15 multiple-choice questions, each with one correct answer. Each correct answer is worth 1 point.
 - 5 open-ended questions.

The maximum number of points for the test is 80.

2. **Second part (practical task)** – Solving a pharmacoeconomics task with 5 sub-questions. Each correctly solved sub-question is worth 2 points. The maximum number of points for a completely correct solution is 10.

The total time for completing both parts is 90 minutes.

Important Notes:

- Students must complete both parts to pass the exam. The test and the practical task are evaluated separately. The final grade is the average of the two parts. If a student receives a poor grade on one part, the overall grade will be "poor" (2).

Reasons for canceling the exam:

- The use and presence of additional electronic devices not handed to the examiners before the start of the exam.
- Cheating and communication between students during the exam.
