The student examination will be conducted according to the following schedule:

Information Regarding the Examination Procedure

- The examination will be held in person, following a prearranged schedule detailing the assigned groups and examination dates.
- Location: Faculty of Pharmacy, 3rd floor, Rooms 302, 304, and 307.
- Start time 9:00 AM on all scheduled dates. Students are required to be present in the examination room no later than 15 minutes prior to the start time.
- All electronic devices must be submitted to the proctors upon entry into the examination rooms and must be switched off prior to submission.
- Students must present their student identification card, bring a blue pen, and have blank sheets of paper available.

Examination Format

The examination comprises both a written part (written part and case) and an oral part, structured as follows:

1. Written Part: Each student will individually draw one examination question from the syllabus.
2. Case: Students will solve a practical case study. During this segment, the use of a drug reference guide and/or the Pharmacopoeia (provided by faculty) is permitted.
3. Oral Part: An oral interview will be conducted, addressing either the written component, the practical case study, or other relevant topics from the syllabus.

The total duration of the examination is **90 minutes**.

Important Notice

Students are required to complete both the written question and the case study in order to receive a grade. Each component will be graded separately. The final grade will be calculated as the arithmetic mean of the two components. Should a student receive a failing grade on either component, the overall grade will be recorded as failing (grade 2).

Examination Invalidation Policy

The examination will be invalidated under the following circumstances:

- The use and presence of additional electronic devices not handed to the examiners before the start of the exam
- Use of unauthorized materials or cheating aids.
- Communication between students during the examination.
