

## **RULES FOR THE HUMAN ANATOMY EXAM FOR PHARMACY STUDENTS**

The exam is held in the auditorium complex and starts **at 8.00 with registration**.

All students in groups sit at 8.00 am for registration with their student books, after which those released from the test go out and wait for the test.

The Anatomy exam consists of examination tests and the writing of a question from the Internal Organs and Nervous system.

**The examination tests consist of the following sections:**

√Cytology and Histology

√Locomotor system

√Internal organs and nervous system (Entrance test)

**Each section of the exam tests is assessed separately. Each successfully passed section of the exam tests is valid for the next sitting of the exam.**

Conducting the test:

- Students who have exempted the relevant section (Cytology and Histology, Locomotory system or Internal organs) do not complete it in the test.

*The test lasts – 45 minutes for a whole test or 15 minutes for a section.*

Written question on a topic from the section Internal organs and nervous system:

- Students randomly withdraw two tickets from the Internal Organs and Nervous System section. Each student chooses and write **only one** of these issues.

*The written part lasts 45 minutes.*

Upon completion of the exam, students are given a date and place for receiving the results.
