DESCRIPTION OF THE DISCIPLINE ENGLISH LANGUAGE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

ANNOTATION

The syllabus includes educational content organized into 4 modules, each of which contains twelve thematic, extended units of general English and is consistent with levels A1, A2, B1 and B1+ of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. The new vocabulary, which is introduced with texts from authentic sources, is related to everyday life, the learning environment and disciplines, as well as the problems of the modern world. The grammatical structures of the language are introduced and mastered inductively or deductively, through controlled and situational exercises with a communicative focus. The main principle of the training is "Learning through doing". Optimization of the lesson work is achieved through work in pairs and in small groups.

The educational content is built on the principles of systematicity and cyclicity, which allows for the consolidation and upgrading of the students' language knowledge and competencies.

Learning Goals

Acquiring knowledge and skills such as reading comprehension, listening comprehension, speaking and writing in English, corresponding to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages for level B1+. The ultimate goal is for students to fully participate in the academic process, acquiring the necessary knowledge in their specialty.

Main tasks

1. Mastering the vocabulary and grammatical structure of the language for successful communication in everyday life and the academic environment.
2. Creating and developing language skills for reading comprehension, writing, listening comprehension and speaking for successful use of the language for social and academic purposes.
3. Teaching learning strategies and autonomy in the acquisition of learning content and its practical application.
4. Acquiring communication skills in a multicultural academic environment through the means of foreign language learning.

Expected results:

Students are expected to be able to:

1. Read and understand general, specific and detailed information in texts that describe situations and events, express feelings and experiences, as well as authentic popular science materials on interdisciplinary topics.
2. Compose a coherent text on familiar topics, describe their experiences and impressions, express a reasonable opinion, defend a thesis, and conduct correspondence.
3. Understand general, specific and detailed information from electronic sources and in oral speech, related not only to familiar topics from everyday life and the academic environment, but also with a specialized focus in the field of medicine and biology (popular science style).
4. Hold a conversation on familiar topics without prior preparation, by expressing an opinion, making a proposal, giving instructions and advice, initiating ideas, highlighting arguments and maintaining successful communication.
5. Tell stories, describe experiences, travels, situations, current events, using clear, structurally organized and logically coherent speech.
